Food for the Flock

St. Boniface Welcome Committee: this is new! Two parishioners came offering to help. I am happy to have Jen Hebert and Karen Husa take the lead on this and anyone who wants to help, let them know! (St. Mary has such a committee already.)

Pro-Life Committee: In response to my request some time back, several folks from both parishes have stepped forward, and we’d like to invite more folks to take an interest. My hope is that our Pro Life Committee do three things: study, pray and act. Stay tuned for an organizational meeting when we’ll set some basic goals and plans as a way to go forward. New baptismal font for St. Boniface: it took a lot of searching for the right one at a good price. I don’t have a picture, it is a fine, white marble font that has been in service for about a century in a church that no longer needs it. I am having it cleaned and prepped, and in the meantime, we’ll get the space ready. No timetable yet for installation. This was made possible by a special donation.

Improving Piqua Catholic: Working with the school board, I recently formed a committee of educators from our parish and school, to consider some possible improvements to the curriculum. This comes in response to suggestions from parents and teachers. Duane Bachman agreed to chair this and I think he’s someone with a lot of credibility and skill.

Piqua Catholic tuition for coming year: the bad news is we did have to raise tuition again by \$150; the good news is, for the first time, we have a “pay in full” discount: if you pay your tuition up front, there is no increase. I’d also like to point out that, while tuition is higher than I’d like, it still represents only about 1/3 of the total cost, and we are about \$200 lower than Sidney or Troy, and we do have financial aid available.

Here’s a way you can actually reduce tuition: do you realize if we were to add just 20 new students, we wouldn’t have to raise tuition at all? Just 20! So how about this? If we work together and add 20 students above our projected enrollment for the coming year, Piqua Catholic will rebate the whole, scheduled tuition increase. If we get half-way there, we’ll rebate half, and so forth!
