Last weekend, I made an announcement at Mass that you may have missed. Here are the facts:

> I am working with the pastoral councils and school board and Lehman, to look at ways to strengthen Catholic education. This is an outgrowth of the cooperative "enrollment initiative" of the past two years, involving our parishes and Piqua Catholic.

> Several ideas have arisen, including possibly a pre-school or junior high changes. We had an informational meeting at which this was discussed.

> The only decision was that I would gather a committee to dig deeper into the ideas raised.

> Well down the road, the committee and I will share any conclusions we have with you. If anything is proposed, it will be put to you for input. We may look hard, and decide our present approach is best.

> No change is "in the wings."

> "The grapevine" can generate rumors far from the facts. You can see there is no cause for alarm.

> I know if any changes are to be made, we need to involve everyone, and that's just what will happen. No surprises, I'll keep you informed.
