### *Food for the Flock*

Strengthen your faith during Holy Week:

**Palm Sunday:** procession at 9 & 10:30 am Masses. **‘Spy Wednesday’** (Judas spies out where Jesus will be): 5:30 pm confessions in St. Boniface Church, Mass at 7 pm. After Mass, the Holy Eucharist will be removed from church to chapel.

**Holy Thursday:** no morning Mass; Morning Prayer 8 am, chapel, instead. Solemn Benediction follows, tabernacle closed. Mass of the Lord’s Supper at 7 pm, St. Mary; recalls institution of the priesthood and the Eucharist; this is the *beginning* of the Lord’s sacrifice, completed on the Cross.

After Mass we make a procession with our Eucharistic Lord, recalling the Apostles going with the Lord to the garden. St. Mary open all night, simple adoration after midnight.

**Good Friday:** tabernacles are *empty*—only day with *no Mass*. Morning Prayer 9 am at St. Mary, confessions 10-11:30 am. Stations 12:15 pm; 1 pm Mid-Day Prayer, 2 pm Solemn Liturgy of Good Friday, Divine Mercy at 3:30 pm. At St. Boniface: Confessions at 5 pm, Stations at 6 pm, Solemn Liturgy at 7 pm.

**Holy Saturday:** 9 am Confessions at St. Boniface; 10 am Morning Prayer for those entering the Church; confessions at St. Mary 3:30-4:30 pm; Vigil Mass, 8:30 pm. at St. Boniface. Long but beautiful.

**Easter Sunday:** Masses at usual times, 7 am—and Vigil—will be the only ones not *extremely crowded*.
